FCUL APPOINTS PRICE AS DIRECTOR OF LEGAL AFFAIRS

Tallahassee—The Florida Credit Union League has appointed Andrew T. “Andy” Price to the newly created position of Director of Legal Affairs. Price joins the League after six years of service with the Florida Department of Banking & Finance and, subsequently, the Florida Department of Financial Services. In his new position, Price will direct the League’s legal efforts, including legal research as it concerns credit unions, strengthen the League’s effort to provide top notch legal and compliance expertise and drafting legislation and official responses to regulatory proposals both on the state and federal levels.

Price will leave his current role of Cabinet and Legislative Affairs Director for the Office of Financial Regulation. Price was originally hired with the Department of Banking and Finance in 1999 as an Assistant General Counsel with his area of work concentrating on securities and finance regulation. Additionally, he served as a Cabinet Aide to Comptroller Robert F. Milligan prior to the departmental reorganization in 2003.

Price received his J.D. from Nova Southeastern University in 1999 and his B.A. from the University of Central Florida in 1996. Prior to attending law school, he was employed as a paralegal in the law firm of Swann & Hadley, P.A. in Winter Park, Florida where his duties concentrated on Commercial and Residential Real Estate, Foreclosures, Banking Law, and Acquisitions and Mergers.

Price will assume his new duties on June 1. Price said that becoming the League’s new Director of Legal Affairs is a challenge he looks forward to.

“I look forward to lending whatever legal experience I can offer,” said Price, “to ensuring that Florida’s credit unions can successfully exist in an environment conducive to the benefit of their members.”

FCUL President/CEO Guy Hood said the League has been looking forward to the day that it could add additional legal and compliance support to an already strong lineup of services.

“Being able to secure the services of someone as talented and knowledgeable as Andy Price,” said Hood, “is noteworthy. The League now has one more resource at hand that will help us serve our affiliates in an enhanced manner.”
